

NUECES ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC.
Security/Street Light Service Agreement
(Minimum Term: 1 Year)

Effective: 12-3-09

Availability

Security/Street Light Service is available to Members, municipalities and governmental authorities in accordance with the Cooperative's Service Rules and Regulations for pole mounted area security and street lighting near the Cooperative's electric distribution lines, in the Cooperative's certificated distribution service area, with existing transformers.

Type of Service

Single phase service at the Cooperative's standard secondary distribution voltages.

MV = Mercury Vapor (no longer available for new installations); HPS = High Pressure Sodium;
 MH = Metal Halide; X= Cobra Head assembly

Monthly Rate

Each billing period the Member shall be obligated to pay the NEC monthly distribution charges for each light PLUS the monthly existing pole charges per light as listed below. In addition, a member must pay the cost of power for the energy usage levels indicated below. The cost of power is based on the price of power as determined by the Member's chosen competitive retail power provider.

New Pole Installation Charge		The setting of a NEW pole for a security light is considered an NEC "new construction project" which may take up to 6 weeks to complete, once scheduled. If the pole is for an existing service location, the customer will be charged the full cost of the materials and labor, and all charges must be paid before the work can be scheduled.													

A member will also be required to pay for additional non-standard items, such as decorative poles, additional transformers, and other distribution services needed to establish new lighting.

Conditions of Service

All security lighting equipment shall be owned, maintained, and operated by the Cooperative. Replacement of lamps shall be made during normal working hours.

The Cooperative reserves the right to discontinue any light where excessive lamp and fixture replacements are required due to vandalism or shooting by firearms.

The Cooperative will, upon the request of the Member, relocate the facility, provided the Member has paid in advance costs the Cooperative had determined it would incur in relocating this facility.

(Over)

The Member shall grant the Cooperative all permits, franchises, or authority including a free and continuous right of way, necessary to construct and operate the system in any manner; the Cooperative shall have the right to remove from the roads, streets or property of the Member any equipment which the Cooperative may have installed to provide the service.

This agreement shall become effective on the date service is first rendered by the Cooperative to the Member hereunder, and shall remain in effect for a period of one (1) year and thereafter until one (1) month after written notice shall be given by either party to the other of its desire to terminate this agreement.

Rates & Billing Adjustments

The monthly distribution charge is subject to change in accordance with the Cooperative's approved tariff and is subject to all applicable billing adjustments. Billing adjustments each period shall be based on the estimated kWh usage derived from total hours of darkness obtained from Nautical Almanac Office, U.S. Naval Observatory (monthly "average" shown for reference).

Retail Electric Provider

Your retail electric provider will bill you for power supplied to your light(s), based on usage as provided by NEC DSP, along with any additional charges for its electric power supply services.

Terms of Payment

Each bill for utility service, regardless of the nature of the service, is due sixteen (16) days after issuance unless such day falls on a holiday or weekend, in which case payment is due on the next work day. In the event payment is not made within sixteen (16) days after date of bill, the member's account will be considered delinquent and, after 10 days, subject to disconnection in accordance with NEC's approved Tariff.
