

1. Customer Service Charge

This charge is a flat, fixed rate to cover NEC's costs for poles, wires, transformers, and equipment. It supports fleet, facility, customer service and administrative functions, such as line maintenance, tree clearing, safety equipment, and general administrative responsibilities.

2. Service Delivery Charge

This charge varies with the amount of energy NEC delivers over the power lines. If you consume less electricity, these charges decrease and increase if you consume more.

3. Power Provider

NEC members have the right to choose their retail electric providers, resulting in separate billing charges for the delivery and power of members. Most providers have chosen to bill separately for their power supply services.

4. Current Charges Due


Current amount to be paid based on electric energy (kWh) consumed.

5. Total Amount Due (after due date)

An amount that has passed the date of payment deadline. Failure to pay the Past Due Amount may result in disconnection of services.

6. kWh Usage History

This chart on your bill includes your current energy usage history along with your average daily uses for the current and previous month.
