SIGN UP FOR OUR RESIDENTIAL CRITICAL CARE LIST

Nueces Electric Cooperative maintains a Residential Critical Care List that includes consumers who have a member of the household on life-sustaining equipment. For those who rely on life-support equipment at home, a power outage could be a matter of life or death. For those who qualify, when possible, NEC makes an effort to notify individuals on this list of planned outage or known pending emergency. Designation as a "critical care" consumer DOES NOT guarantee uninterruptible power supply. Take them to your doctor and they can fax the appropriate documents to us.

Take these steps to prepare for power outages:

- Consider investing in a portable generator or learning more about our Generac Program, which can power vital equipment in the event of an extended outage.
- Make arrangements to move in temporarily with friends or family during a power failure if a generator is impractical
- Keep an adequate supply of prescription drugs and medical equipment on hand
